

MINUTES OF THE SVPOA GENERAL MEETING – SEPTEMBER 16, 2020

MEETING VIA ZOOM

Ed Steil called the meeting to order at 3:10 PM / Adjourned at 3:40 PM

Finance (Steil)

The Board had approved the SVPOA 2021 Budget.

Welcome Back Party (Steil)

The Welcome Back Party in 2021 will be held at the Dillard House on June 6, 2021 and will be fully paid by the POA.

Membership (Maus)

The POA currently has 346 members with 14 new members this year. In addition, 16 homes sales occurred during the last two months.

POA Membership Dues are due October 1st; \$70 for family membership and \$40 for single membership

A special thank you was extended to all POA members for supporting the POA this year.

Finances (Morley)

The POA currently has \$46,000 in the bank. Any current shortfalls in the 2020 budget will be covered by collections during the 4th quarter of 2020. The Budget has been approved for 2021.

By-Laws Change (Steil)

The By-Laws change necessary to reflect the change in the financial year of the POA to a calendar year will be considered during the Annual Meeting in October.

Special Announcement (Palmer)

Debi Palmer announced that the 40th Anniversary of the Sky Valley Chapel is in November, 2020. To celebrate that Anniversary, the Chapel is having a special service on October 11th at 10:00 AM. Following the service, there will be an Open House at the Chapel from 11:30 AM until 1:30 PM. Everyone is invited to attend the Service and/or the Open House. Light refreshments will be served.

Programs (Darrah)

Jamie introduced the program presenter, Jeff Harris – the new owner of the Piggly Wiggly in Dillard. Jeff Harris was the Sky Valley Police Chief during 2006-2008 and purchased the Piggly Wiggly (The Pig) at the beginning of 2020. Mr. Harris is striving to create a community store and has worked hard on improvements, not only to the store, but also to the products carried in the store. He asked if there is something you would like to see carried in the store, please let him or Sterling, the Manager, know.

The Pig contributed all of the chicken and pork served at the Sid Weber Memorial Cancer Fund Bar-b-que held earlier this year. In addition, The Pig has been opening the store after-hours to allow local students from Rabun Gap-Nacoochee and Tallulah Falls Schools to shop in a safe environment. Mr. Harris also indicated that he would be willing to donate some for the POA Pancake Breakfasts when they start up again next year.
